



Improving road infrastructure safety in the Baltic Sea region – BALTRIS has started in 11th June 2010. In this Project there are 7 partners involved from Lithuania, Estonia, Latvia and Sweden. The involved partners are academical institutions and road administrations.

Project lead partner is Lithuanian Road Administration under the Ministry of Transport and Communications.

Project inaugural meeting was held on 3rd and 4th of February 2011 in Sweden.

Project is ongoing till December 2012.

The BALTRIS project is expected to lead to improved safety of road infrastructure as well as possibilities to choose cost-effective engineering solutions. Safer road infrastructure will result in improved overall road safety

Safe transportation is important, especially considering that the increasing road traffic volumes in the Baltic Sea Region come at the price of accidents during which lives are lost and injuries caused. The road safety must be further improved to help reduce the number of accidents, fatalities and injuries. In the BALTRIS project authorities and academic institutions in Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania and Sweden work together for improved road safety.
