#### Introduction

- 1.1 Ernst Moritz Arndt University (University of Greifswald):
  - ♦ Founded in 1456 by Heinrich Rubenow
  - One of the oldest universities in Germany
    - 7th rank according to the year of foundation
    - 4th rank according to years of existence
  - ♥ Great significance for the region:
    - Impact on the economy
    - Production of knowledge (research)
  - ♦ A good place to study:
    - Top rankings with respect to teaching and research
    - Sharp increase in the number of students since 1992

#### Introduction

#### 1.2 The Faculty of Law and Economics:

- ♦ Faculty of Law as one of the founding faculties
- Since 1915: Faculty of Law and Economics
- \$\infty\$ Forced to close in winter 1945/46
- ♦ Reopened in 1992
- ♦ At present:
  - 27 professors (Economics: 12)
  - about 2.700 students (almost evenly distributed)
  - A variety of programmes:
    - Econs: Diploma, M.Sc. Health Care Management
    - Law: Staatsexamen, BA Law & Econs, MA Tax Law



# Cooperation between our faculty and TZV

- Two important links:
  - Exchange of knowledge
  - ♦ Common projects
- Exchange of knowledge
  - Support of project applications
  - ♥ E.g., in the area of the business start-up (project: EXIST)
- > Common projects
  - FlairPlus: Provides support for business start-ups at universities and research facilities
  - Ideenwettbewerb: Search for innovative and creative ideas for business start-ups by students and scientists
  - Move2health: Much like FlairPlus but geared to medical engineering

## **Future projects**

- The Faculty of Law and Economics has plenty of ideas for future projects!
- > E.g., two future topics will be:
  - \$\to\$ eMobility (e.g., e-cars, e-bikes, and their impact)
  - individualised medicine (integrating telemedicine, cooperation with GANImed)
- Background: Western Pomerania as a region of tourism and of health promotion
- Tasks:
  - Profitability analysis
  - ⇔ Evaluation of legal and economic impact
  - ♦ Identify improvements in infrastructure required to implement projects

## A Problem and a proposal for a solution

- To realize ideas for projects, the TZV needs a variety of national and international partners
- > Problem:
  - ♦ How to identify potential project partners?
  - Particularly relevant for the Baltic Sea region
- Solution: Set up a body which
  - \$\times\$ organizes workshops or other meetings
  - 🕏 establishes and fosters a network for entrepreneurs, cities, ...
  - nay act as a contact for international large size projects
